Players to watch:

QB Karé Lyles:

Karé Lyles, born on May 1, 1998, in Madison, Wisconsin, is emerging as a standout quarterback for the Prague Lions in the European League of Football (ELF). With a diverse background in American football, Lyles brings a unique skill set and a winning mentality to the field. Lyles' football journey began in his hometown, where he honed his skills playing for the Scottsdale Outlaw Football team. He then made his mark at the collegiate level, representing renowned programs such as the Wisconsin Badgers, the Scottsdale Fighting Artichokes, the Southern Illinois Salukis, and the Jackson State Tigers. In 2023, Lyles ventured to Europe, joining the New Yorker Lions in the German Football League (GFL). His debut season in Germany was nothing short of impressive, as he showcased his talent by completing 139 passes for 1,745 passing yards and 23 touchdowns, along with two rushing touchdowns in 11 GFL games.

Beyond his on-field accomplishments, Lyles comes from a football family, with a brother who played as an offensive lineman and a father who excelled as both a quarterback and a tight end. His deep-rooted passion for the game is evident in his commitment to excellence, as showcased by his decision to pursue a starting spot in Germany over opportunities in the USFL or XFL.

RB Tyrese Johnson-Fisher:

Tyrese Darnell Johnson-Fisher is an accomplished athlete with a diverse sports background. He excelled in track at Oakham School and with Croydon Harriers, winning the 60m National Indoor Finals in 6.89 seconds and placing third in England at the U17 Championships in the 100m with a time of 10.73 seconds. Tyrese also played rugby for Oakham School, Leicester Tigers Academy, and the Jamaican Rugby Sevens National Team.

His football career includes stints with the London Warriors (2018, 2022), Coastal Carolina University Chanticleers (2018), Copiah Lincoln Community College Wolves (2021), Istanbul Rams (2022), Berlin Rebels (2023), and Prague Lions (since 2024). Notably, he ran a 4.38-second 40-yard dash and was the first international player in the 2018 Under Armour All-America Game, despite never playing high school football.

In the ELF, he recorded 126 yards and two touchdowns in four games in 2022 before being released by the Rams after Week 4. Despite no known team or individual awards, Tyrese's impressive athleticism and sports versatility stand out.

RB Adam Žouželka:

Adam Žouželka, born on October 30, 2001, in Přerov, Czech Republic, is a dynamic force as a running back for the Prague Lions in the European League of Football (ELF). With a remarkable journey in the world of football, Žouželka has established himself as a versatile and impactful player, poised to make significant contributions to his team's success.

Žouželka's football odyssey began with the Přerov Mammoths, where he honed his skills before transitioning to the senior level with the Ostrava Steelers in 2021. Previously, Zero also played in Poland for the Bydgoszcz Archers and won the German Bowl with the New Yorker Lions. His versatile skills as a runner and receiver make him a valuable addition to any team.

WR Travier Fields-Jackson: On IR

In his senior year, Brooks made a personal decision to transfer to the University of North Alabama. Following his collegiate career, he embarked on a professional journey, signing with the Cologne Falcons in the German Football League in 2013. Brooks continued to excel in the

international football scene, playing for teams like the Kozły Poznań in Poland and the IBM Big Blue in Japan's X-League. His impressive performances earned him accolades, including multiple All-Star selections and recognition from American Football International as part of the All-Pandemic Team in 2020. Brooks also made appearances for the Prague Lions in the Czech League ČLAF in 2016 and 2018. Additionally, he served as the defensive coordinator for the Prague Black Panthers in the 2019 season of the Austrian Football League.

In 2023, Brooks joined the Prague Lions for the inaugural season of the European League of Football under the helm of Head Coach Zach Harrod.
