#1 QB Carlton Aiken Jr.

Carlton Aiken Jr., born on July 6, 1998, in Paulsboro, New Jersey, is a quarterback known for his versatility on the field. In 2023, the 25-year-old Gibbstown native showcased his skills for the Barcelona Dragons in the ELF, completing 25 of 60 passes for 354 yards and two touchdowns, while also rushing for 149 yards and a touchdown in two games. During the same year, Aiken Jr. played for the Silesia Rebels in the PFL, where he threw for 1,100 yards and 17 touchdowns without any interceptions. He also rushed for over 700 yards and 11 touchdowns, leading the Rebels to the Polish Bowl. Collegiately, Aiken Jr. had stints at Central Connecticut State, Gardner-Webb University, and Pace University, where he accumulated impressive statistics. In total, he recorded 5,887 passing yards and 55 touchdowns, along with 1,964 rushing yards and 23 touchdowns during his college career. Named the NE10 MVP in 2022, Aiken Jr. has proven himself as a dynamic player both at the collegiate and professional levels. He continues his football journey with the Helvetic Mercenaries starting in 2024, aiming to further showcase his talent on the field.

Nazir offers elite ball skills, with the ability to track and grab at the point of attack, he is a pure balhawk. As a former basketball player, Streater has the explosive mobility most defensive backs dream of.

Stadium:

The Helvetic Mercenaries will play in two different stadiums this season: The Stadion Brühl for their home opener and Sportzentrum Kleinfeld for the following games.

Brühl Stadium: Capacity: 12,500. Originally opened as "Brühl Arena" in 1950, the stadium underwent several renovations and expansions over the years. In 1978, it was renamed "Brühl Stadium" and has since been a prominent sports venue in the region. The most recent renovation took place from 2014 to 2016, costing approximately €20 million. Brühl Stadium serves as the home ground for Brühl City FC, a local football club, and also hosts various other sporting events and concerts throughout the year.

Kleinfeld Sports Center: Located in the heart of the city, Kleinfeld Sports Center boasts a capacity of 5,000. Originally established in 1982, the sports center has undergone multiple upgrades and expansions to accommodate the growing demand for recreational and

competitive sports activities in the community. The facility hosts a wide range of sporting events, including soccer matches, basketball tournaments, and track and field competitions. Additionally, Kleinfeld Sports Center provides state-of-the-art training facilities for local sports clubs and athletes.
