

Players to watch:

QB Jack Mangel:

Quarterback Jack Mangel, hailing from Athens, Georgia, is a rising star in American football. He made a significant impact during his college years at Concord University from 2020 to 2023. Mangel's talent on the field earned him recognition and accolades, including breaking numerous records for completions, passing yards, and passing touchdowns in Concord's history. In 2022, Mangel's stellar performance led to him being named an Honorable Mention All-American, showcasing his exceptional skills and leadership on the field. Prior to this, he was also selected for the All-Mountain East Conference Second Team in 2021 and elevated to the First Team in 2022. Mangel's standout season in 2022 saw him propel Concord to one of the most formidable passing offenses in Division II football, amassing an impressive 3,667 yards and 39 touchdowns through the air. His remarkable achievements include setting a record for the most passing touchdowns in a single season, solidifying his place as a standout quarterback.

WR Nathaniel Robitaille:

Wide receiver Nathaniel Robitaille, born on November 26, 1992, in Attleboro, USA, boasts an impressive football career across various leagues. His journey began at Attleboro High School, where he excelled as a member of the Bombardiers football team from 2007 to 2010. He continued to shine at the collegiate level, playing four years of football at Stonehill College as a standout wide receiver and return specialist. During his time at Stonehill College, Robitaille showcased his talents by recording 196 receptions for 2,739 yards and 25 touchdowns. Additionally, he made significant contributions as a return specialist, tallying 23 kick returns for 555 yards. Robitaille's success continued as he transitioned to professional football. He ventured into the European football scene, joining the Frankfurt Universe in 2016 before moving on to the Schwäbisch Hall Unicorns from 2017 to 2019. In 2020 and 2021, he played for the Seinäjoki Crocodiles before joining Rhein Fire for the 2022 and 2023 seasons. Throughout his career, Robitaille has garnered numerous accolades, including selections to All-Conference teams, MVP honors, and All-Star recognitions. Notably, he was a key contributor to multiple championship-winning teams, clinching titles such as the EFL Bowl, German Bowl, and ELF Championship. In the ELF, Robitaille's performance has been exceptional, earning him recognition as the ELF MVP of the Week and a spot on the All-Star First Team in 2022.

TE Henry Rowland:

Tight end Henry Rowland, born in 2001 in the United Kingdom, has emerged as a promising talent in the world of football. His journey began at the prestigious NFL Academy, where he honed his skills and developed a passion for the game. Following his time at the academy, the now 23-year-old athlete returned to the UK and showcased his talents at the Loughborough University. During his tenure at Loughborough University, Rowland played a

pivotal role in the team's success, helping them secure the BUCS Trophy championship in 2023. His outstanding performance on the field earned him recognition as the Offensive Player of the Year. Subsequently, Rowland ventured into the domestic football scene, representing teams such as the Tamworth Phoenix and the London Warriors. His remarkable abilities as a tight end caught the attention of scouts, leading to opportunities on the international stage. Two years ago, the 6-foot-4-inch pass catcher made his debut for the British national team, showcasing his skills in matches against Italy and France. His stellar performance during the 2022 season attracted interest from scouts in Canada, who invited Rowland to participate in the CFL international Combine.

DE Malik Crenshaw:

Known for his strength, discipline, and ability to seamlessly integrate into a team, Crenshaw brings a formidable presence to both sides of the ball. His aggressive playing style and physicality make him a standout performer on defense, where he excels as a disruptive force. Crenshaw honed his skills during his college football career at East Central University before transitioning to pursue professional opportunities. His experience includes a season with the Düsseldorf Panther in 2023.

DE Jebrai Regan:

Defensive end Jebrai "Jay" Regan holds the distinction of being the first officially signed player for the Hungarian franchise, the Fehérvár Enthroners. Born on February 22, 1994, in Woodstock, Georgia, Regan has been a cornerstone of the Enthroners' defense since 2017. Following his naturalization in 2022, the 28-year-old now holds Hungarian citizenship in addition to his American roots. Regan honed his skills at Gardner-Webb University, where he emerged as a standout player in his final two years, earning a starting role on the team. Throughout his career, Regan has established himself as a dominant force on the field, boasting an impressive track record as a sack leader in both the Hungarian Football League (HFL) and the Japanese X-League Super.

Renowned for his prowess as a defensive end, Regan's impact extends beyond his ability to disrupt opposing offenses. In his inaugural season in the European League of Football (ELF), the 29-year-old demonstrated his defensive prowess, amassing 9.5 sacks, 52 total tackles, 17 tackles for loss, and four forced fumbles. His stellar performance earned him recognition among the top players in the league, solidifying his status as a defensive standout and a vital asset to the Enthroners' defensive unit.

CB Roedion Henrique:

Cornerback Roedion Henrique has traversed continents in pursuit of his football dreams, hailing from Curaçao, where he was born on December 22, 1993. His journey through various teams and leagues showcases his resilience and talent on the field. Henrique's football odyssey began with the Amsterdam Panthers before he ventured to Reedley Junior College Tigers in 2013–2014. His skills caught the attention of recruiters, leading him to join the New Mexico State University Aggies from 2015 to 2016, where he studied Kinesiology



while making significant contributions to the team's defense. In 2019, Henrique made his mark in the German Football League (GFL) with the Hildesheim Invaders, exhibiting his prowess with 62 tackles, three interceptions, five pass break-ups, and a forced fumble in 15 games. His standout performances earned him invitations to prestigious events like the NFL International Combine in 2019 and the CFL Global Combine in 2022. Joining the Leipzig Kings from 2021 to 2023, Henrique continued to shine, showcasing his versatility and defensive prowess. Despite facing adversity, including a season-ending injury in the 2023 season opener, Henrique's impact on the field remains undeniable.

Capacity: 3012. Opened in 2016. In 2018 a gym and an additional artificial turf field were built at the facility. In 2020 a roof was installed to cover the main stand. The stadium is not only the home of the Enthroners but also to the Fehérvár Lions, the local ultimate frisbee team. It is also the venue for the Hungarian football national team's home games and hosted the 2021 Hungarian Bowl. The annual "Fezen Festival", a metal, hard rock and rock festival is held there, that featured stars like Alice Cooper or The Offspring in the past.

Head Coach & Offensive Coordinator - Joe Ashfield:

Joe Ashfield, a seasoned football coach with over two decades of experience, assumed the role of Head Coach for the Fehérvár Enthroners in the European League of Football (ELF) in 2023. Prior to leading the team, he served as the Offensive Coordinator and was later promoted to Head Coach towards the end of 2023. With a background in coaching at various college programs, including Rice University and Stanford University, Ashfield brings a wealth of experience to his role. Although specific details about his age remain undisclosed, Ashfield's football journey traces back to his time as a member of the football team at Saint John's University in Minnesota in 1999. Over the past two decades, he has established himself as a prominent figure in the coaching realm, particularly renowned for his expertise as an Offensive Coordinator and Head Coach across college and professional teams. Ashfield's coaching career has seen him make significant contributions to various college programs, notably Stanford University from 2005 to 2006 and 2013 to 2017, as well as Rice University from 2018 to 2020. In 2023, Ashfield assumed the role of Head Coach for the Fehérvár Enthroners in the ELF, where he continues to make significant contributions. Joining Black Hills State University in 2020, Ashfield served as the Quarterbacks Coach and Pass Game Coordinator, further enriching his coaching portfolio.

Defensive Coordinator - Vince Okruch

Vince Okruch, born on August 9, 1955, in Buffalo, USA, is a seasoned football coach with a



wealth of experience in both college football and European leagues. With a career spanning over 35 years, Okruch has held various coaching positions at prestigious college football programs, including Illinois, Western Illinois, Northwestern, and Ohio State. Throughout his career, he has had the opportunity to collaborate with renowned figures in college football such as Lou Holtz, Bill McCartney, Gary Barnett, and Urban Meyer. One notable stint in Okruch's career was his time with the University of Colorado football team, where he served as the Co-Defensive Coordinator and Outside Linebackers Coach. Following the passing of his colleague Tom McMahon, Okruch assumed the role of Defensive Coordinator, showcasing his versatility and leadership within the coaching staff.

In addition to his contributions to college football programs, Okruch has also made an impact in European leagues. In 2023, he served as the Defensive Coordinator for the Munich Ravens in the European League of Football (ELF). His expertise and strategic prowess on the defensive side of the game earned him recognition and paved the way for his appointment as the Defensive Coordinator for the Fehérvár Enthroners in Hungary for the 2024 season.
